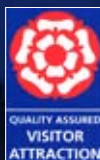

The new Museum will chronicle the history of the Guernsey Militia from the medieval period up until 1939 when it was disbanded.

It will showcase the vibrantly coloured uniforms from the 18th, 19th and early 20th Centuries as well as a wealth of weapons, equipment and accoutrements. In addition the displays will feature musical instruments, silverware and medals. The public will also have access to a digital database of the Museum's entire Militia photographic archive. Sound effects and animated media will enhance the visitor experience.

THE STORY OF GUERNSEY

See the 'cabinets of curiosities' established by Victorian gentlemen collectors. The Story of Guernsey begins with archaeological treasures from the age of Neolithic dolmen-builders and continues with the Bronze Age hoards and relics of Guernsey's many Iron Age warrior burials. It continues through the middle ages into the 20th century, touching on our island industries of farming and tourism. Additional displays explain the geology of the islands and the rich variety of wildlife.

Housed in the former Castel Manual Telephone Exchange, exhibits range in time from Mechanical Telegraphy in 1809, the first electric submarine telegraph to England in 1858 to the start of the telephone service in Guernsey in 1898. Rare early examples of telephones, relics of the German Occupation and phones familiar from the 1950's onwards are on show. With early fax machines and video-phones, the story continues through to the present day.

A hands-on guided tour is on offer which allows the visitor to explore 200 years of telecommunications in Guernsey.

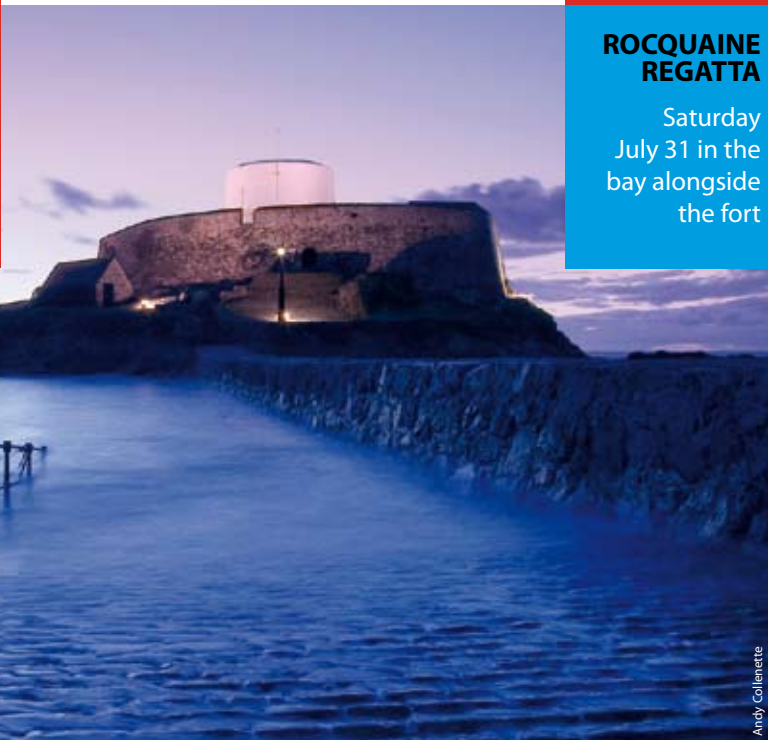

THE FORT

Discover Fort Grey, which is known locally as 'the Cup and Saucer'. Overlooking one of Guernsey's magical west coast bays, the Martello Tower was erected in 1804 to defend Guernsey against the French and was manned during both world wars.

In 1976 it was restored and converted into a shipwreck museum.

THE MUSEUM

Investigate the tower and its fascinating collection relating to shipwrecks around the treacherous west coast of Guernsey. From HMS Sprightly, wrecked on the Hanois Reef in 1777, to the sad story of MV Prosperity which foundered on the rocks off Perelle in January 1974 after the crew had abandoned ship and all 16 of them drowned.

The display will remind you of the bravery of sailors as they face the perils of the sea.

THE STORY OF CASTLE CORNET

Discover the history of the castle from prehistoric times to the Second World War. Follow how it was built and expanded to meet new threats and learn about some of the people who lived here.

MARITIME MUSEUM

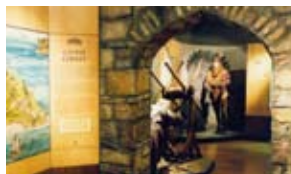

Objects from the unique Roman ship, relics of the island's privateering days and displays of its shipbuilding industry are on view. The 16th century Sutler's Garden is planted with a variety of herbs for kitchen use.

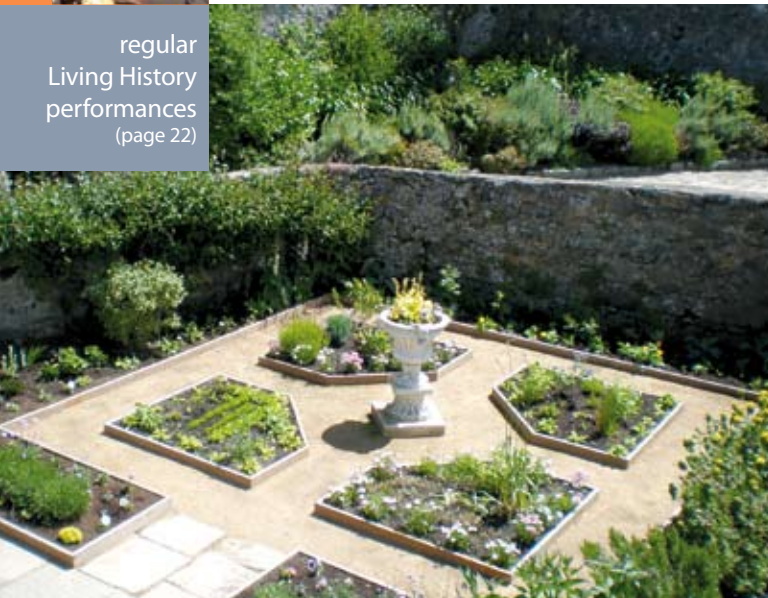
Lambert's Garden design reflects an interest in medicinal herbs.

HISTORIC SITES

Guernsey Museum has over 70 historic sites in its care including a range of archaeological sites, medieval buildings, castles, 18th and 19th century fortifications and German Occupation defences. These sites give a fascinating insight into over 6000 years of Guernsey's history.

VICTORIA TOWER

Built in 1848 to commemorate Queen Victoria's visit to Guernsey two years earlier. The tower is locked but the key can be collected from Guernsey Museum & Art Gallery during normal opening hours. From the viewing platform there are spectacular panoramic views across the island.

The Guernsey Museum Archaeology Group carries out a wide range of archaeological activity throughout the year, including fieldwalking, excavation, and post-excavation work on the finds. The sites investigated cover every period of the island's history, from the earliest inhabitants of eight or nine thousand years ago, right through to the present day.

Guernsey Museum & Art Gallery can be enjoyed by people with limited mobility, including wheelchair users. There is a disabled toilet. Audio guides are also available to assist the partially sighted.

Castle Cornet and **Fort Grey** can only be accessed by a flight of stairs, have no disabled toilets and are not suitable for wheelchair users. Persons with limited mobility or the partially sighted need to be aware that the interiors include uneven surfaces, steps and staircases.

The **Telephone Museum** has no disabled toilet. Wheelchair users can access the Museum, but will find space restricted. It has no stairs.

If a disabled person is accompanied by an essential companion, both can be admitted for the price of a single adult ticket. A wheelchair is available for use on request at the Guernsey Museum & Art Gallery. Please ask a member of staff.
