This concert which accompanies the exhibition 'Mervyn Peake's Sark' at the Guernsey Museum & Art Gallery is part of the celebrations remembering the birth of the writer and artist Mervyn Peake (1911-1968). It presents a glimpse into Peake's world and his enduring fascination and love for the small island of Sark.

Sark was Mervyn Peake's home on two separate occasions, firstly as a young man just after he left the Royal Academy Schools and then again with his family. Throughout Peake's life, Sark served as a sanctuary as well as being the inspiration for many of his creative works.

The music has been chosen as a direct response to Peake's work, particularly that created while living on, or directly inspired by Sark.
